These nurturing spaces foster both academic and personal growth, breaking the cycle of poverty and empowering students to build brighter futures.

Women's Empowerment & Vocational Training:

To promote financial independence among women, DSF runs vocational training centers offering skills in tailoring, handicrafts, and design. These programs provide women with the tools and confidence to start businesses or secure employment, fostering long-term self-sufficiency.

Healthcare & Hygiene:

DSF delivers holistic healthcare through regular check-ups, dental and eyecare camps, deworming, nutritional support, etc. Special emphasis is placed on health education, including menstrual hygiene and breast cancer awareness, ensuring dignity and well-being for women and girls.

Environmental Stewardship:

DSF advances environmental protection through awareness campaigns and hands-on initiatives like tree planting, waste reduction, and water conservation. Women and children are trained as "Green Ambassadors," promoting eco-friendly practices within their communities.

The Divine Shakti Foundation (DSF) has been actively engaged in numerous initiatives from April 2022 to March 2023. Much of this annual year was affected by the pandemic and our efforts to support the community during these challenging times. Below is a chronological summary of key activities during this period:



MENSTRUAL Hygiene Day

28 May 2022: During the Sacred Manas Ram Katha, HH Pujya Swami Chidanand Saraswatiji emphasized that women's health is national health, stating that menstruation is not just a women's issue but a matter affecting families and society at large. He called for an end to the silence around menstruation, which often disrupts the lives and education of young girls, and urged collective action across all platforms. Pujya Sadhvi Bhagawati Saraswatiji added that women spend nearly seven years of their lives menstruating, underscoring the need for increased awareness, care, and access to menstrual hygiene. They both led a mass pledge and raised awareness on this issue amongst thousands of devotees attending the Katha and many more watching it live-stream.





HH PARAM PUJYA SWAMI CHIDANAND SARASWATIJI'S

70th Birth Anniversary

3 June 2022: On the occasion of DSF's Founder HH Param Pujya Swami Chidanand Saraswatiji's 70th birth anniversary, the Pujya Chidanand Merit Swami Saraswatiji Scholarship Fund was inaugurated to honor his lifelong dedication to education and empowerment. Launched under the Divine Shakti Foundation and led by Pujya Sadhvi Bhagawati Saraswatiji, the fund aims to support deserving students in pursuing higher education at prestigious institutions across India. Scholarships will be awarded annually on Pujya Swamiji's birthday.

As part of the 7-Day Guru Dedication Service Week celebrating Pujya Swamiji's 70th birth anniversary, a free two-day eye camp was held on June 7–8, 2022, at Shukdevanand Charitable Hospital, Rishikesh. Organized by DSF in collaboration with several charitable organizations, the camp provided vision therapy, spectacles, and medicines to 1,400 patients from surrounding regions including Haridwar, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Delhi, and Agra, etc.







MARMA CHIKITSA

Medical Camp

17-18 JUNE 2022: The Marma Chikitsa Medical Camp hosted at Shukdevanand Charitable Hospital, was organized by DSF, with a commitment to promoting holistic health and traditional healing systems. Organized in collaboration with Uttarakhand Ayurved University, the camp provided free treatment to hundreds of patients suffering from chronic and lifestyle-related ailments. By offering both therapeutic services and educational training in ancient Marma therapy, the initiative supported DSF's mission of empowering communities with accessible, integrative healthcare rooted in India's rich Ayurvedic wisdom.

June 2022: Health awareness and hygiene session conducted at a Government Girls' School, attended by over 150 students; included free distribution of sanitary napkins and informative pamphlets.

DE-WORMING AND NUTRITION NUTRITION AWARENESS

Kanwar Mela









14–26 JULY 2022: After a nearly two-year gap due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Kanwar Yatra – an annual holy pilgrimage observed by the devotees of Lord Shiva – returned on July 14th, much to the delight of the thousands of pilgrims that had been yearning for this sacred journey for so long. As part of its commitment to compassionate service, DSF supported a 12-day free medical camp organized near Baghkhala, Rishikesh, along the route of the Kanwar Mela. Led by Dr. Priyaji and a dedicated team of sevaks, the camp provided essential medical care to over 12,000 Kanwariyas suffering from fatigue, injuries, infections, and other ailments. Youth Day



12 August 2022: On International Youth Day, the DSF inaugurated the Shakti Vikas Kendra, a new educational facility aimed at empowering students from Classes 8–12. Offering free coaching in both life skills and academics, the center prepares students for competitive exams such as Bank PO, SSC, JEE, and Railway services. Aligned with DSF and Parmarth Niketan's vision, the initiative ensures that financial limitations do not hinder any child's pursuit of education and personal growth.



FREE MEDICAL CAMP MOHAN CHATTI,

13 August 2022: In celebration of India's 75th Independence Day, a free health camp was organized for diabetic and dental patients, treating over 275 underserved individuals. The initiative was run by DSF and the National Medicos Organization (NMO), Seema Dental College, with an announcement to hold regular bi-monthly camps going forward.

BREAST CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAM AT DSF CENTRE'S PARMARTH

18 August 2022: Women and girls were trained in breast self-examination and educated on lifestyle changes, such as adopting yogic practices and reducing the use of chemical cosmetics, to help prevent cancer.

DEWORMING DRIVE

23 August 2022: 260 students received deworming tablets, accompanied by a hygiene awareness session emphasizing sanitation practices to prevent infections.

INAUGURATION OF NEW EDUCATIONAL FACILITY

23 August 2022: On this beautiful International Youth Day – the day set aside to raise awareness about cultural and societal issues related to Youth, this year focusing on the theme 'Inter-Generational Solidarity', Building a Better World for All Ages to Foster Positive Relationships – the DSF, with the inspiration and blessing of Pujya Swamiji and Sadhvi Bhagawatiji, inaugurated its newest educational facility –

Shakti Vikas Kendra – designed to develop life and other skills in students from Class 8-12, and to help them discover their passion and fulfill their dreams. All classes will be free because Parmarth Niketan and DSF both believe that no child should be deprived of education due to lack of money, and everyone should be allowed to achieve their goals and realize their aspirations.

HOMEOPATHY CAMP

29-30 August 2022: A two-day homeopathy camp treated 100 patients from multiple states, offering free consultations and medicines for common ailments. Dr. Kunjal Upadhyay emphasized the spirit of selfless service.

DENTAL HYGIENE

MEDICAL CAMP AT PARMARTH

29 September 2022: A one-day camp served 300 people, primarily children, providing dental, eye, diabetic, and digestive checkups along with deworming treatments, led by experts from Seema Dental College and Nirmal Ashram.

NAADI YOGA HEALING CAMP

1 October 2022: Hundreds of patients received non-medicinal healing through touchbased Naadi Yoga therapy, highlighting the body's innate capacity to heal itself.

ARTIFICIAL LIMB AND PHYSICAL THERAPY CAMP

19 September - 11 October, 2022: In partnership with Mahaveer Seva Sadan, this camp provided artificial limbs, calipers, and therapy to the differently-abled, aiming to create a "Divyang-Mukt Uttarakhand." The initiative was praised by Uttarakhand's Chief Minister and Pujya Swamiji for promoting dignity and self-reliance.

Mental Health Day

10 October 2022: Mental wellness camp featuring expert-led sessions on stress, anxiety, and resilience, conducted for both youth and adults.

Handwashing Day

The event featured water experiments, games, poster-making, soap-making demonstrations, and a quiz, reinforcing life-saving hygiene habits in a joyful setting.

Patients received **free meals and accommodation**. Doctors from India, the US, Australia, and Nepal generously offered their expertise.

14 November 2022: Children's Day was celebrated with students of DSF's Shakti Vikas Kendra, providing academic support and career guidance to underprivileged youth. The event was filled with inspiration, affirming the power of education in transforming lives and empowering dreams.

NATIONAL PLANNING MEETING

Divyang-Free India

15 November 2022: A strategic meeting in Kolkata, led by Swami Chidanand Saraswatiji and partner organizations, laid the groundwork for expanding the "Divyang-Mukt Bharat" initiative across the country.

SELF-HELP GROUP

SHG Meet



18 November 2022: Divine Shakti Foundation organized a Self-Help Group Meet at Parmarth Niketan, bringing together SHGs from Rishikesh, Dehradun, and Haridwar. The event provided a platform for women entrepreneurs to showcase and sell their handmade and home-produced items, including bags, coasters, dresses, stoles, decorative pieces, and edible goods. The gathering fostered community support, empowerment, and economic opportunity for rural and urban women artisans.

SPECIAL MEDICAL AND DENTAL CAMP FOR

World Children's Day

20 November 2022: A free medical and dental camp was held at Gandhi Ashram, Delhi, with a special focus on 225 children from Bapa Ashram School and Kasturba Balika Vidyalaya. Organized by DSF, GIWA, Seema Dental College, and Harijan Sevak Sangh, the camp included health check-ups, dental screenings, hygiene education, and the distribution of hygiene and first-aid kits. Children participated in guided yoga, meditation, and interactive WASH sessions, promoting holistic health, cleanliness, and well-being.

UNITED NATIONS ALLIANCE OF CIVILIZATIONS

Morocco

23 November 2022: At the UNAOC Plenary Session, DSF's President Pujya Sadhviji addressed global faith and policy leaders on redefining peace to include access to clean water, food, and sanitation. She emphasized overcoming polarization through faith-based unity and sustainable development, advocating for a compassionate, inclusive future. Pujya Sadhviji traveled to the sacred spiritual city

of Fez, Morocco to deliver a speech in the plenary session of the United Nations Alliance of Civilizations (UNAOC) Global Forum. High level government representatives, civil society leaders and faith leaders from around the world gathered to work to find active and sustainable pathways to peace and towards an Alliance of Peace: Living Together as One Humanity.

THE RELIGIONS FOR PEACE CONFERENCE

Manresa, Spain

30 November 2022: The Religions for Peace conference, a multi-religious and intergenerational forum, focused on addressing social and environmental crises. Pujya Sadhviji delivered an impactful speech on sustainable urban living, emphasizing DSF's transformative work in areas such as gender equality and climate action through mass tree plantations.

FREE MEDICAL CAMP AT PATNA VILLAGE

Uttarakhand





29 November 2022: Organized with Seema Dental College, Parmarth Niketan, and NMO, this camp brought medical and dental care to nearly 100 villagers and students across five mountain villages. Volunteers trekked 3 km on foot due to rough terrain, marking the first medical outreach in the area in 26 years. A true testament to DSF's commitment to underserved communities.

GITA JAYANTI AND

Science Exhibition





3 December 2022: On December 3rd, 400 students from three schools gathered at Parmarth Vidya Mandir to celebrate Geeta Jayanti. The event featured 24 innovative science projects tackling climate change, pollution, and sustainable technologies. Students presented creative solutions like rainwater harvesting and alternative energy sources. The celebration, which included songs, dances, speeches, and Bhagavad Gita recitations, was judged by scientists from the Wildlife Institute of India. The event concluded with the distribution of winter tracksuits to all the children.

MENSTRUAL HYGIENE

Awareness Session

7 December 2022: DSF's Menstrual Hygiene team led a session for women in a marginalized community in Rishikesh, educating them on menstrual products and hygiene. Each participant received an eco-friendly menstrual kit, including reusable cloth pads and a storage pouch, promoting sustainable and dignified menstruation practices.

FREE HEALTH & HYGIENE CAMP

Gandhi Ashram, Delhi

17 December 2022: This follow-up camp in December served 175 patients with medical and dental care, including treatments for children. A joint effort by GIWA, DSF, AIIMS, Seema Dental College, and Harijan Sevak Sangh, the initiative exemplified ongoing commitment to community health.

29 December 2022: Sadhvi Bhagawatiji, DSF's President was a keynote speaker at the Women Economic Forum in Delhi, where she joined global women leaders to promote entrepreneurship, leadership, and empowerment through collaboration and shared purpose.

A SPECIAL WILDLIFE AND GANGA

Awareness Session

3 February 2023: A special Wildlife and Ganga Awareness session was held at DSF's Parmarth Vidya Mandir School in Rishikesh, co-organized by the Wildlife Institute of India (WII) and Namami Gange. WII officials discussed the importance of water, shared fascinating facts about Mother Ganga, its wildlife, and how to preserve its ecosystem and keep the river clean.
