Divine Shakti Foundation (DSF), with the divine blessings and guidance of Parmarth Niketan President **Pujya Swami Chidanand Saraswati Ji**, successfully organized a **Free Multispecialty Medical and Dental Camp** in collaboration with **Medanta Hospital, Gurugram**, and **Seema Dental College and Hospital**. The primary objective of this initiative was to make quality, modern, and accessible health care available to underprivileged communities residing in remote and hilly regions, where access to advanced medical facilities is often limited.

The camp was conducted over two days at two different locations to ensure maximum outreach and benefit. On the **first day**, the camp was held at **Bukhandi, Vidyavasini Temple**, and on the **second day**, it was organized at **Swami Shukdevanand Charitable Hospital, Parmarth Niketan**. Both locations witnessed an overwhelming response from the local population, reflecting the pressing need for such healthcare initiatives in the region.



Inauguration and Blessings

The camp was inaugurated with prayers and blessings, setting a spiritual and compassionate tone for the medical service. On this occasion, Pujya Swami Chidanand Saraswati Ji, President of Parmarth Niketan, expressed his heartfelt gratitude to Dr. Naresh Trehan, Chairman of Medanta Hospital, Gurugram, and his entire team for their continuous commitment to serving humanity through selfless medical care. Swami Ji emphasized that true service lies in reaching the unreached and ensuring that quality healthcare becomes a right, not a privilege.



Medical and Dental Services Provided

A dedicated team of experienced doctors from Medanta Hospital, including cardiologists, general physicians, and other specialists, along with a skilled dental team from Seema Dental College and Hospital, participated in the camp. A wide range of medical and diagnostic services were provided free of cost, including:

- General health consultations
- Cardiology consultations
- Blood pressure and blood sugar testing
- ECG (Electrocardiogram)
- BMD (Bone Mineral Density) tests
- PFT (Pulmonary Function Tests)
- Dental check-ups and treatments

In addition to consultations and diagnostics, **essential medicines** were distributed free of charge to the patients, ensuring continuity of care beyond the camp days.





Beneficiaries and Impact

The camp directly benefited hundreds of people, primarily from rural and hilly areas. A significant number of beneficiaries included elderly individuals, women, youth, and daily wage workers, many of whom had never previously undergone specialized medical tests due to financial or geographical constraints. The patients expressed deep gratitude for the opportunity to receive expert medical advice and treatment close to their homes.

The initiative not only helped in early detection of health issues such as diabetes, hypertension, cardiac concerns, and dental problems, but also created awareness about preventive healthcare and the importance of regular medical check-ups.

Continuation of Medical Services

Following the successful completion of the first day, the same team conducted the medical camp on the second day at Swami Shukdevanand Charitable Hospital, further extending the reach of the initiative. Notably, this hospital also serves as a center where Medanta Gurugram OPD operates regularly from Monday to Saturday at Parmarth Niketan, ensuring sustained access to high-quality healthcare for local residents and pilgrims alike.

Currently, Dr. Vivek Sabharwal, MBBS, DNB, PGDCED (UK), Consultant Internal Medicine and Diabetologist, is providing regular medical services at the OPD. This ongoing collaboration has significantly improved healthcare accessibility for communities living near Parmarth Niketan and surrounding areas.

The Free Multispecialty Medical and Dental Camp stands as a shining example of collaborative service, compassion, and commitment to public welfare.
